
The food and drink industry is really exciting at the moment.

The company and brands draw upon their rich 'Rum Triad' – rooted in Jamaica's rummaking traditions, showcasing the culture and flavours of East Africa, blended with Scotland's proud distilling heritage. As a result, they are producing some of the most adventurous and unique rum expressions available anywhere in the world.

Their mission is to produce a maverick range of artisan rums for those looking for greater authenticity, increased quality, and genuine depth of flavour. They produce the full spectrum of rum styles – from high-quality unaged white rums to smooth, cask-aged rums and aromatic, spiced, and fruity-flavoured ones. This drives their portfolio approach – building their success around two signature brands, Matugga and Liv, and allows them to target diverse consumers and different drinking occasions.

Their rums have been recognised by global drinks experts through several prestigious global awards, including an Outstanding Gold medal from the International Wine & Spirit Competition (IWSC) for our first 3-year-old rum. The duo also offer contract distilling and a private rum cask ownership programme.

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
